## NOTICE OF INTENDED DECISION

**I INTEND TO MAKE AN ORDER** under section 69 of the *PBA* that the **Retirement Plan for the Employees of Dubreuil Forest Products Limited** Registration **366468** (the “Plan”) be wound up effective **January 17, 2011**.

### **I INTEND TO MAKE THE ORDER FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:**

**There was a cessation or suspension of employer contributions to the pension fund.**

**The employer is Bankrupt within the meaning of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada)*.**

**Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.**

**YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING** by the Financial Services Tribunal (the “Tribunal”) pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. **To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Intended Decision is served on you.**<sup>1</sup>
