## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

**I PROPOSE TO MAKE AN ORDER** under section 69 of the *PBA* that **Pension Plan for the Employees of Jerome Taylor Pontiac Buick GMC Inc.** (the "Plan ") be wound up effective April 16, 2009.

### REASONS:

**There was a cessation or suspension of employer contributions to the pension fund.**

**The employer failed to make contributions to the pension fund as required by the *PBA*.**

**A significant number of members have ceased to be employed by the employer as a result of the discontinuance or reorganization of all or part of business of the employer.**

**Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.**

**YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING** by the Financial Services Tribunal (the "Tribunal ") pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. **To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.**<sup>1</sup>
